



## Admission To Pools Rules

- 1. Admission to the pool is limited to members of Lake Chesterfield Homeowners Association who are in good standing, only by using your Key scan card**
2. Entrance and Exit through main pool gate only
- 3. No children under 13 years of age will be permitted in the pool area unless accompanied by a responsible resident 16 years or older.**
4. Admission to the pool is refused to all persons, having a contagious or infectious condition, inflamed eyes, skin abrasions, open wounds, or who is wearing bandages.
5. Admission to the pool is refused to any LCHOA member or any guests of member who **are obviously intoxicated (see related rule 14)**. If LCHOA member is refused entry, all guests of that member will not be admitted to the pool. If member or any of their guests become belligerent and will not leave the pool access gate, City of Wildwood police, at the discretion of lifeguard may be called to escort those persons from the premises.
6. Children of diaper age (infants & toddlers) must wear rubber pants in addition to any diaper they are wearing , or diapers specifically made for swimming
7. Only swimming apparel will be allowed, no shorts, cut-offs, leotards, thong suits will be permitted.
8. No oily suntan lotion will be permitted, due to the damage it does to the filters. Other lotions must be in plastic bags.
- 9. NO GLASS OF ANY KIND, FOR ANY REASON, IS PERMITTED INSIDE POOL AREA**  
See associated Rule Violations & Penalties Section.

## Guests Rules

- 10. Limit of six guests per family per day. Homeowner must accompany their guest at the pool at all times. Lending HOA member's key card to a guest is prohibited.**
11. Guests may be limited, barred or removed if the Pool Manager, Trustee or On Site Manager deems the pool to be too crowded.

## Food, Drink, Smoking Rules

12. Food and Drink are limited to tables and perimeter areas. \*However, with **caution** drinks in cans may be held while in pool.
- 13. All POOL AND AREAS INSIDE The POOL FENCE WILL NOT ALLOW TOBACCO PRODUCTS (SMOKING or CHEWING), as of August 2011. This includes e-Cigarettes and/or Vapor Cigarettes.**
- 14. While the consumption of alcoholic beverages is permitted, persons who become in a state to be **deemed intoxicated** by demonstrating inappropriate behavior, being mentally incapacitated, using foul language, etc. to the detriment of others, may be asked to leave the pools at the discretion of the Lifeguards. Uncooperative persons may be escorted from the pools by City of Wildwood police. See "Rule Violations" below.**

## Splash Pool Rule

15. No one over 6 years old is permitted in the Children's Splash Pool (small pool located directly behind Club House). What appears to be older children in pool will be asked to leave the pool by the life guards.  
**Exception** –The guardian of a young child may be in the Splash Pool to ensure the child's safety.

## Adult Pool Rule

16. The adult pool is limited to persons 18 years or older



### Activities While In The Pool Rules

17. No child will be permitted in the deep water section of the pool unless they have demonstrated their ability to swim one width of the pool and to tread water for AT LEAST 30 seconds, to the satisfaction of the lifeguards on duty.
18. Running, rough play, roughhousing, obscene gestures are prohibited at all times. The lifeguard, at their discretion, has the authority to enforce a “time out” policy to anyone not conducting themselves in a proper manner. The lifeguard has the authority to ask any person(s) to leave the pool area for improper conduct and/or language. It is the responsibility of all HOA adult members to know the rules and explain them to their children and their guests.
19. **No Diving, regardless of pool depth.**
20. No piggy back games. No flips off the side of the pools **or** on the pool decks.
21. Only battery operated radios will be permitted pool side and volume kept at a courteous level, so as not to disturb others in the pool area.

### Children’s Toys Rules

22. Air mattresses and swim fins shall be allowed but must be under the direct supervision of an adult. They are also limited to times when the lifeguard feels their use will not interfere with other swimmers.  
Rubber Rafts/Tubes are **not** permitted.
23. **Frisbees and Water Balloons NOT ALLOWED.** Nerf balls, and Water Guns are allowed except when using for rough play. All other balls or toys may be declared unsafe at the discretion of the Lifeguard.
24. Skates, skateboards, roller blades, bicycles and Chewing Gum **are not Permitted** in the pool area

### **Injury Rule**

25. All injuries, however slight, must be reported to the lifeguard and properly documented.

### **Chairs, Lounges, Tables, Umbrellas Rule**

26. Chairs and lounges are primarily for use by adults. Children should relinquish them when the pool deck is full

### **Pet Rule**

27. No dogs or other pets will be permitted in the pool area.

### **Party Rule**

28. The pool **may NOT** be used for private parties after normal operating hours. Small pool parties may be held during normal pool hours with no more than Six guests, per Resident. Please contact LCHOA Site Manager for details and scheduling availability.

### **Club Property Rule**

29. Damage to club property including trees, shrubs and flowers will not be permitted and any member that causes such damage will be held personal and financially responsible.

### **Waste Material Rule**

30. All waste material must be placed in the proper disposal containers

### **Lost And Found Rule**

31. All items left in the Pool Area after hours will be placed in the Lost & Found baskets under the stairs. All unclaimed items will be purged Weekly (on Monday mornings before the pool opens)



## Pool Closing Rules

32. The pool may be closed for maintenance, health conditions, weather or any reason deemed necessary by the pool manager.

## Inclement Weather Condition Rules

33. **Lighting/Thunder** declared by Pool Lifeguards on duty.

All people in and around the pool will be instructed to get to an enclosed area, not stay in an open area, under a tree or near anything metal. Wait until Pool Lifeguard gives the **all clear signal**, which could be up to 30 minutes, from what is believed to be the **last sound of thunder heard** before resuming activity in or around the water. Each time thereafter that **thunder is heard or lightning is seen**, the time starts over.

**Tornado** - declared by Pool Lifeguards. Clear the pool and pool area. Take shelter in locker rooms or indoors. Do not leave the shelter until the tornado has passed as declared by lifeguards.

## Rule Changes

34. All rules are subject to change **without prior notice**, if conditions require.

## -----Rule Violation Penalties-----

### 35. Disciplinary Penalties:

- a. 1<sup>st</sup> Offense - Warning
- b. 2<sup>nd</sup> Offense – Sit out for 15 minutes
- c. 3<sup>rd</sup> Offense – Ejection from the pool for the remainder of the day
- d. 4<sup>th</sup> Offense – Ejection from the pool for the remainder of the week
- e. 5<sup>th</sup> Offense – Ejection from the pool, until next LCHOA Board meeting

At the next board meeting, it will be decided that your access card may or may not be revoked for the remainder of the season.

### 36. Disciplinary Penalty: Intoxication

Immediate ejection from the pool for the remainder of the day.

If member becomes intoxicated at the pool on a regular basis, member's pass status may be a topic for discussion at next monthly LCHOA Board meeting.

**37. GLASS BROUGHT INSIDE POOL AREA Penalties:**

First offense	Fine of up to \$50
Second Offense	Fine of up to \$100
Third Offense	Fine of up to \$250
Fourth Offense	Board of Trustees will consider legal action; privileges revoked until review is completed.

**If glass is broken in or around the pool, fees/fines for cleaning the area(s) up to \$2500 will be assessed.**

If any person has a complaint regarding behavior of another pool patron, it is to be reported to the lifeguard on duty.
